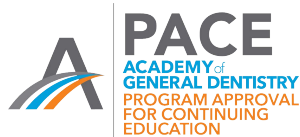

It is the goal of the United States Dental Tennis Association:

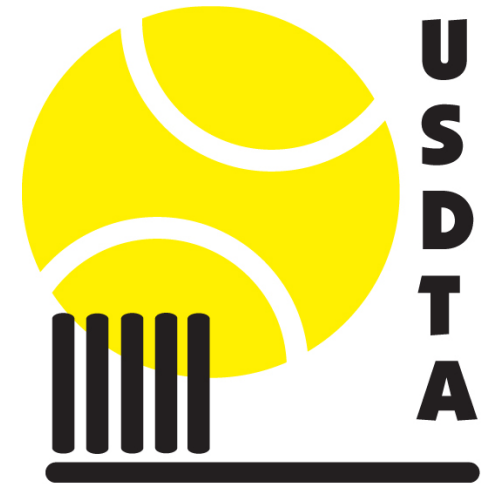
To provide continuing education courses with a timely message to dental practitioners of general and all specialty groups and auxiliaries in a time when change seems to be the rule.
